Purpose:	The purpose of the Weapons Policy is to protect this tax-exempt organization's (Organization) Volunteers. This policy is intended to supplement but not replace any applicable state, federal and local laws, as well as individual faire rules, governing weapons applicable to nonprofit and charitable organizations.

Terms and Definitions:	The following terms, definitions and acronyms are used in this document:
Interested Person	Any new volunteer is an interested person.
1. Policy:	Volunteers must meet the minimum age restriction of 12 years of age to carry or wield a weapon of any kind. User must demonstrate proper handling and be approved by the Guild Master, or their designee, to carry or wield said weapon.
1.1 Procedures	Volunteers should discuss the purchase of any new weapons with their Guild Master, or designee, to determine if they will be able to wield the weapon at OSRP events. For new Volunteers, they should present their weapons to their Guild Master or designee for approval.
1.2 Periodic Reviews	To ensure the Organization operates in a manner consistent with charitable purposes and does not engage in activities that could jeopardize its tax-exempt status, periodic reviews shall be conducted. The periodic reviews shall, at a minimum, include the following subjects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Whether the Weapons Policy is reasonable. b. Whether the Weapons Policy is ethical and does not in any way conflict with any laws or statutes.
