Purpose:	The purpose of the Weapons Policy for Minors [general] is to protect this tax-exempt organization's (Organization) Volunteers. This policy is intended to supplement but not replace any applicable state, federal and local laws, as well as individual faire rules, governing weapons applicable to nonprofit and charitable organizations.
Scope:	This policy applies to all OSRP Volunteers and children under 18.

Terms and Definitions:	The following terms, definitions and acronyms are used in this document:
Interested Person	Any member of the public is an interested person.
OSRP Volunteer	Any person who is gate listed with OSRP (St. Barbara's or St. Genesius) at any given faire.
Weapon	Any item created from wood, steel, or other metal with a blade, edge, point or intended to be used for the purpose of mass or individual destruction (to include, but not be limited to : trebuchets, catapults, knives, daggers, swords, etc.).
1. Policy:	Any child under the age of 18 within our encampment and/or using our weapons, must, after having obtained permission from their parent(s) or guardian(s) and the Guild Master, be supervised by a parent or guardian with an OSRP Volunteer observing at all times. This includes whether the child is simply firing one of the table top catapults, or is 'sparring' with swords. We reserve the right to temporarily confiscate any weapon used in an unsafe manner in or near our encampment.
1.1 Periodic Reviews	To ensure the Organization operates in a manner consistent with charitable purposes and does not engage in activities that could jeopardize its tax-exempt status, periodic reviews shall be conducted. The periodic reviews shall, at a minimum, include the following subjects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Whether the Weapons Policy for Minors [general] is reasonable. b. Whether the Weapons Policy for Minors [general] is ethical and does not in any way conflict with any laws or statutes.
